Pre K 4: 18 children with 1 teacher and 1 teaching assistant

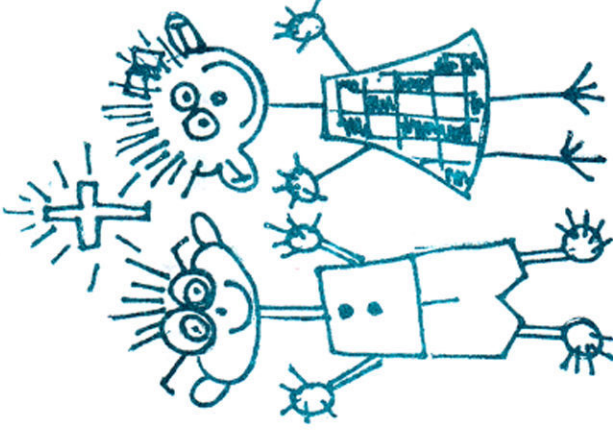
Final ratios are to be determined by the Director.

Preschool Supply and Parent Committee Activity Fee \$160.00

Terrific Twos:

- * Monday/ Wednesday OR Tuesday/ Thursday classes
- * Must be 2 years and 6 months of age as of September 1st this year
- * Class Times: August and September 9:00am - 11:30am then October thru May 9:00am - 12 noon
- * We encourage child to be potty-trained.
- * Tuition Cost: \$1650.00 or ten payments of \$165.00

Pre K 3:

- * Monday/ Wednesday/ Friday OR Tuesday/ Thursday classes
- * Must be 3 years old as of September 1st this year
- * Class time is 9:00am - 12 noon
- * Tuition Cost: M/W/F \$2250.00 or ten payments of \$225.00
- * Tuition Cost: T/Th \$1850.00 or ten payments of \$185.00

Pre K 4:

- * Monday through Friday
- * Must be 4 years of age as of September 1st this year
- * Two Pre K 4 classes
- * Class time is 9:00am - 12 noon
- * Child must be potty-trained
- * Tuition Cost: \$2650.00 or ten payments of \$265.00
- * Lunch Bunch: Sept-April on Wednesdays til 1:30 p.m. for an additional cost paid monthly.
- * Cooking Fee: \$30.00

Curriculum

A Three-pronged Developmental Readiness Program with low staff/ student ratios is offered for all age groups.

Spiritual/ Emotional/ Social

Bible activities, and weekly Chapel for all classes held on Wednesdays, encourage children to grow in faith and to develop responsible Christian behaviors. In all our classes, our teachers, by example and through curriculum and supportive relationships with the children encourage them to:

- * See themselves as secure children of God
- * Respond to God's Love by being concerned for and compassionate to others and by caring for those in need
- * Develop a respect for and a desire to protect and care for God's creations

Cognitive

A developmental readiness program based on the Creative Hands-On Curriculum recommended by the National Association for the Education of Young Children, combined with Work Jobs, encourage the children to develop the skills needed for success in Kindergarten.

Physical

Both large and small muscle co-ordination are developed through age appropriate activities in the classroom and on the playground.
